

BEQUESTS TO UNITINGCARE NSW.ACT

Recommended wording for a bequest to UnitingCare NSW.ACT:

“I give to the Uniting Church in Australia Property Trust (NSW) for the benefit of UnitingCare NSW.ACT based in Sydney, NSW, Australia:

- the sum of \$_____ (cash)
- and/or _____% of my total estate
- and/or the rest and residue of my estate
- and/or Life Insurance Policy Number _____ in _____ company (insurance company)
- and/or a specific item of property _____

To be used by UnitingCare NSW.ACT for such of its general purposes as the Board of UnitingCare NSW.ACT may decide, and I declare that the receipt of the treasurer or other authorised officer of the Property Trust shall be a sufficient discharge to my executors who shall not be obliged to see to the application thereof.”

To leave a bequest for a specific UnitingCare NSW.ACT program or service

you may wish amend the last paragraph of the above as follows:

...To be used by UnitingCare NSW.ACT for [insert specific projects, e.g. Newpin, Younger Onset Dementia Central Coast, Dubbo Doorways]. I declare that the receipt of the treasurer or other authorised officer of the Property Trust shall be a sufficient discharge to my executors who shall not be obliged to see to the application thereof.”
